Upon inspection of Legacy Cars it has come to our attention that some seat belts are out of date. It is the drivers responsibility to make sure that their seat belt restraint system is current by manufacture date. All drivers ó **It is the responsibility of the driver, not CompCar of NC, to insure that his/her seat belt and head and neck restraint system and all components are approved, correctly installed, maintained and properly used.**

SEAT BELTS

Manufacturer specifications shall take priority regarding all safety equipment.

An approved five point safety harness with 3" minimum wide belts equipped with a quick release buckle is mandatory in all cars. The driver must use the seat belt restraint system at all times on the race track, in accordance with the instructions and/or recommendations of the system supplier and/or manufacturer. The seat belt restraint system must be installed in accordance with the directions provided by the system supplier and/or manufacturer. The date of manufacture must remain visible on the belts at all times. Seat belt restraint systems must not be used beyond two (2) years after their date of manufacture or in accordance with manufacturers' specifications.
